### TO PLAY A COURSE

1. Once logged in you will see three folders in the left panel ..."Assigned", "Started" and "Completed".

The American National Standards Institute (ANSI), working with the Chemical Manufacturer`s Association (CMA), has developed the first standard format for Material Safety Data Sheets.

While this new MSDS format is not required under the OSHA Hazard Communication Standard, OSHA is encouraging its use. Perhaps as important, most of the large chemical manufacturer`s in the United States appear to be adopting this MSDS format.

# **ASBESTOS AWARENESS**

In August of 1994, OSHA issued 29 CFR 19100.1101... "Occupational Exposure to Asbestos." This regulation requires that all employees who could come into contact with materials that might contain Asbestos be given appropriate training on working safely in these situations.

The largest groups of employees covered by this regulation are maintenance and custodial workers, since many materials commonly used in buildings for many years (including ceiling tiles, vinyl flooring, and wall and pipe insulation) contain Asbestos. This means that the regulation applies to virtually every custodial, janitorial and maintenance worker in the country.
